Alastair Marsh

Alastair Marsh will be stepping down as Group Chief Executive Officer of Lloyd's Register Group (LR) on 31 December 2020 with a view to taking on some non-executive and advisory roles.

He joined LR in 2007 and was promoted to Chief Financial Officer in April 2008 and joined the Board. He was appointed as CEO in October 2015. During his tenure as CEO, Alastair has led the Group through a modernisation and transformation strategy founded on significant investment in systems and processes, together with a customer and innovation focused culture change programme. LR is well positioned for future growth as a leading, global professional services company supporting clients in critical infrastructure sectors.

Alastair is a qualified Chartered Accountant and prior to joining LR, worked for Price Waterhouse before holding a number of senior financial management positions within the high-tech manufacturing, chemicals, software and ICT sectors.

Alastair is a member of the Global Maritime Forum Advisory Council and a Trustee of the Royal Museums Greenwich, where he chairs the Audit and Risk Committee.

Nick Brown is currently Marine & Offshore Director for Lloyd's Register Group (LR) and will become Group CEO on 1 January 2021.

Nick joined LR in 1996 as a Marine Surveyor and has worked across the business in a variety of leadership roles around the world, including President of LR's operations in China for seven years.
