The ship finance landscape is evolving under the combined pressure of shifting patterns of market liquidity, tightening regulation, and changing investor priorities. This panel will assess how the sale and purchase market is responding to volatile freight conditions, and whether the growing demand for retrofitting is reshaping investment decisions and financing structures. It will also explore how Basel IV and rising compliance costs are impacting traditional lenders, while considering the evolving role of Asian leasing, private credit, and other alternative finance providers. The discussion will conclude by considering whether emerging ESG frameworks are creating a two-track market, influencing not only the cost but also the availability of capital for shipowners.
